Number of Seats : 60 (Sixty per year)

Course Duration : 2 academic years

Eligibility for Admission : Pass in Higher Secondary/VHSE or equivalent examination with an aggregate of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics/Biology.

Course Progression :

As per syllabus Education Regulation 2020 prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India and the examining authority D. Pharm Board of Examinations, Directorate of Medical Education , Govt. of Kerala, with not less than 180 working days in each academic year and not less than 3 hours for theory and 3 hours for practical classes on each working day.

II. B Pharm (Bachelor of Pharmacy)

Number of Seats : 100(hundred per year).

Course Duration : Four academic years divided into eight semesters.

Eligibility for Admission : Pass in Higher Secondary/ VHSE or equivalent examination with an aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics /Biology.

Course Progression : As per syllabus prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India and with examining authority, Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, with not less than 200 working days in each academic semester and not less than 3 hours for theory and 4 hours for practical classes on each working day and a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical classes separately.

Lateral Entry to B. Pharm in the Second Year (Admission directly into Third Semester B. Pharm)

Course Duration: Three academic years divided into six semesters.

Eligibility for Admission : Pass in D. Pharm (under Education Regulations 1991 of Pharmacy Council of India) from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and examination conducted by the Kerala State Board of D Pharm Examinations or equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in the final year examinations. Candidates should have obtained registration with State

Pharmacy Council and the registration certificate is to be produced at the time of counseling or candidates should have applied for registration with State Pharmacy Council and the proof thereof is to be produced at the time of counseling.

Course Progression : As per syllabus prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India and with examining authority, Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, with not less than 200 working days in each academic semester and not less than 3 hours for theory and 4 hours for practical classes on each working day and a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical classes separately.

III. Pharm D (Doctor of Pharmacy)

Number of Seats: 30(Thirty per year)

Course Duration: 6 academic years, five years of study and one year of internship or residency) full time.

Eligibility for Admission: 1) 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects: Mathematics or Biology (2) A pass in D.Pharm course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act (3) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the

above examinations, provided that a student should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

Course Progression : As per syllabus prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India and with examining authority, Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, with each academic year spread over a period of not less than 200 working days. The period of six years duration is divided into two phases: Phase I—consisting of first, second, third, fourth and the fifth academic year and Phase II—consisting of internship or residency training during the sixth year involving posting in speciality units with a minimum 80% attendance in theory and practical classes separately.

IV. M Pharm (Master of Pharmacy In Pharmaceutics)

Number of Seats : 15 (Fifteen per year)

Course Duration: Two academic years.

Eligibility for Admission : B Pharm degree from an Indian Institution approved by PCI and KUHS with a CGPA of not less than 5.50 (aggregate of 3rd semester to 8th semester) or not less than 55% of maximum marks (aggregate of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year B Pharm).

Course Progression : As per syllabus prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India and with examining authority, Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.
